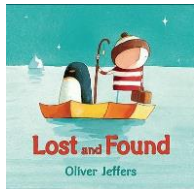
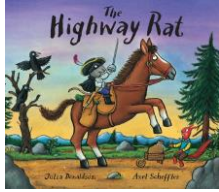

Key Areas of Learning

Our values this term will be **Respect** for the first half of the term then **Responsibility** for the second half of the term.

As **Historians** we will be learn about Florence Nightingale. We will make comparisons between nursing and hospitals then and now.

As **Scientists** we will be learning about animals including humans.

ENGLISH

This term we will focus on a selection of stories by Julia Donaldson and Oliver Jeffers. We will sequence events and identify characters and settings. We will also identify our likes and dislikes about the stories and discuss puzzles and patterns in the stories. We will work to develop our ability to identify and extend rhyming patterns.

Our non-fiction writing will be linked to our history work. We will write about Florence Nightingale.

MATHEMATICS

In maths we will build on our ability to count, recognise and order numbers. We will develop our understanding of addition and subtraction and also begin to develop our understanding of multiplication and division.

We will find $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ of shapes and amounts. We will also identify 3D shapes and estimate and measure length.

SCIENCE

In Science we will be learning about animals including humans. We will identify and categorise animals and identify their needs. We will also look at similarities and differences between animals.

We will identify ways to care for our teeth, learn why exercise is important and also why it is important to wash our hands.

PE

In PE we will continue to focus on balancing, travelling and coordination. We will also learn some basic yoga.

RE

In RE we will be talking about people who are important to us. We will also talk about people who help us.

COMPUTING

In computing we will build on our existing computing skills and exploring basic programming using Scratch.

PSHCE

We will be exploring this term's values of Respect then Responsibility through group discussions in class and through 1:1 conversations.

Through our work and play, we will work to develop our social interaction, including our skills of sharing and turn taking. This will help us to develop friendships with other children.

MUSIC

In Music we will be learning some new songs as well as singing lots of our favourite songs. We will explore the pulse and rhythm of music by clapping and playing instruments.

ENRICHMENT

We will continue with horse riding, swimming and visits to Thomley this term.
