Key Areas of learning

As **Geographers**, we will be looking at similarities and difference between Marston and other localities in the UK and abroad.

English

Children will be:

- writing a recount about their Christmas holidays
- getting to know the story of 'Lost and Found' by Oliver Jeffers and using it to create their own story
- identifying features of a **non-chronological report** and using the features to write non-chronological reports about penguins
- joining in with **rhymes and poems**; comparing and performing poems

Maths

Children will be:

- counting, reading and writing the numbers to 100 in numerals and words
- looking at shapes and patterns
- counting in 2s and 10s
- using maths skills and vocabulary to solve problems
- focussing on the numbers to 20
- ordinal number

Science

Children will be:

- exploring different types of materials for keeping warm
- exploring habitats in the arctic and animals that live there
- observing how different materials change eg: water to ice
- using scientific vocabulary

Computing

Children will be:

- using the chrome books and computers to create pictures
- using a word processing program to present their own work

PSHCE and P4C

Children will be:

- reflecting and think about our value, Independence, during assemblies and discussions in class
- using stories to help them to understand what friendship means and why it is important
- exploring questions from our class text 'Lost and Found'

Music

Children will be:

- given the opportunity to listen to different types of music, including classical
- exploring and choosing different percussion instruments
- singing new and familiar songs and rhymes
