Key Areas of Learning

As **Historians** we will be learning about how the NHS has changed and the jobs that are done. We will be thinking about jobs we may want to do.

ENGLISH

The children will

- Learn the story of Dr Dog, explore the story and innovate it to make it their own.
- Learn to tell the poem *The Owl and the Pussycat*
- Write poems about the body
- Compose a piece of writing about the NHS.
- We will continue reading Paddington and start George's Marvellous Medicine.

MATHEMATICS

The children will:

- Find fractions of shape and amount.
- Add 2 3 digit numbers whilst regrouping the tens and ones.
- Measure in cm and add measurements.
- Learn the 5 x table and related facts.

SCIENCE

The children will:

- Describe how animals obtain their food from plants and other animals, using the idea of a simple food chain. Identify and name different sources of food.
- Find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air)

PE

The Children will continue to follow the Real PE scheme. Our focus will be on working creatively whilst learning balls skills and balances.

RE

The children will:

- Learn about the Traditions of Chinese New Year.
- Learn different religious views on creation.

ENRICHMENT

We will be having a Healthcare professional day on 11/1/2019.

PSHE

The Children will explore what they are good at and how these skills can help them achieve their life goals.
